CRITERIA

No qualifications are required. Students will complete the MIT Diagnostic Test and interview process for acceptance onto the course

START DATE AND TIMES:

The programme runs for 20 weeks and coincides with the MIT semester dates in February and July. Classes are from 9am - 2.30pm Monday to Friday.

Course structure allows for flexibility during school holidays - great for those students with family commitments. This course is run at both the Manurewa and Panmure sites.

COURSE COSTS:

Solomon Group, in co-operation with MIT, offers this course for only \$520 - less than one quarter of the cost at the Otara Campus. Student Loans and Allowances are available.



Graduation takes place at the MIT Marae

Study grants may be available for Work and Income clients.

REQUIREMENTS:

Adult students of all ages are welcome at this course. Minimum age 16 years.

Once students are accepted onto the course they will complete an enrolment form and organise method of payment. To finalise enrolment, the student will need to provide one form of identification such as.
